- Have you a disability impacting your ability to participate?

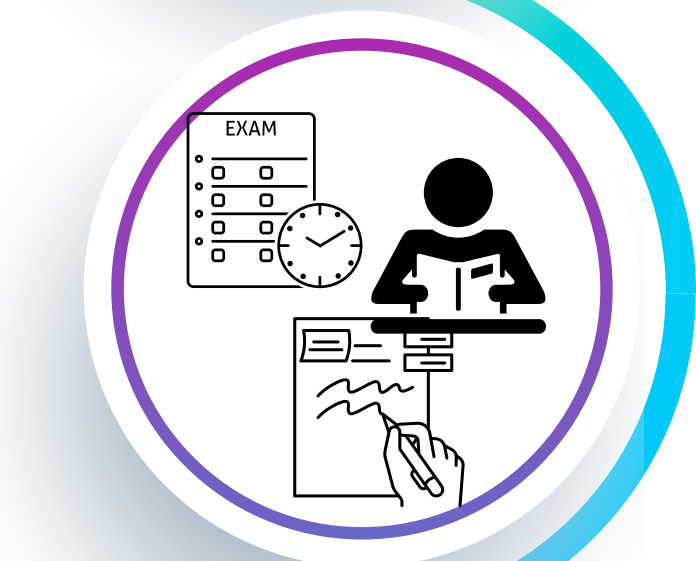


Adult Education Service Balbriggan and Swords can provide supports to individuals with a range of learning needs.

## LEARNER SUPPORT WHO CAN APPLY FOR HELP?

Learners who have a disability, mental health condition, learning difficulty, significant illness or other conditions. For Example:

- Blind/Visual Impairment
- Deaf/Hearing Impairment
- Mental Health Condition
- Physical Disability
- ADD/ADHD
- Autism Spectrum Disorders/Asperger's Syndrome
- DCD (Dyspraxia/Dysgraphia)
- Specific Learning Difficulty (Dyslexia/Dyscalculia)
- General Learning Difficulty
- Significant on-going illness
- Neurological conditions eg. brain injury, speech and language disabilities
