## REASONABLE ACCOMMODATION WHO CAN APPLY?

Learners who have a disability, mental health condition, learning difficulty, significant illness or other conditions. For Example:

Blind/Visual Impairment Deaf/Hearing Impairment Mental Health Condition Physical Disability ADD/ADHD Autisim Spectrum Disorders/ Asperger's Syndrome DCD (Dyspraxia/Dysgraphia) Specific Learning Difficulty (Dyslexia/Dyscalculia) General Learning Difficulty Significant on-going illness Neurological conditions eg. brain injury, speech and language disabilities
